

Birds are animals that have:

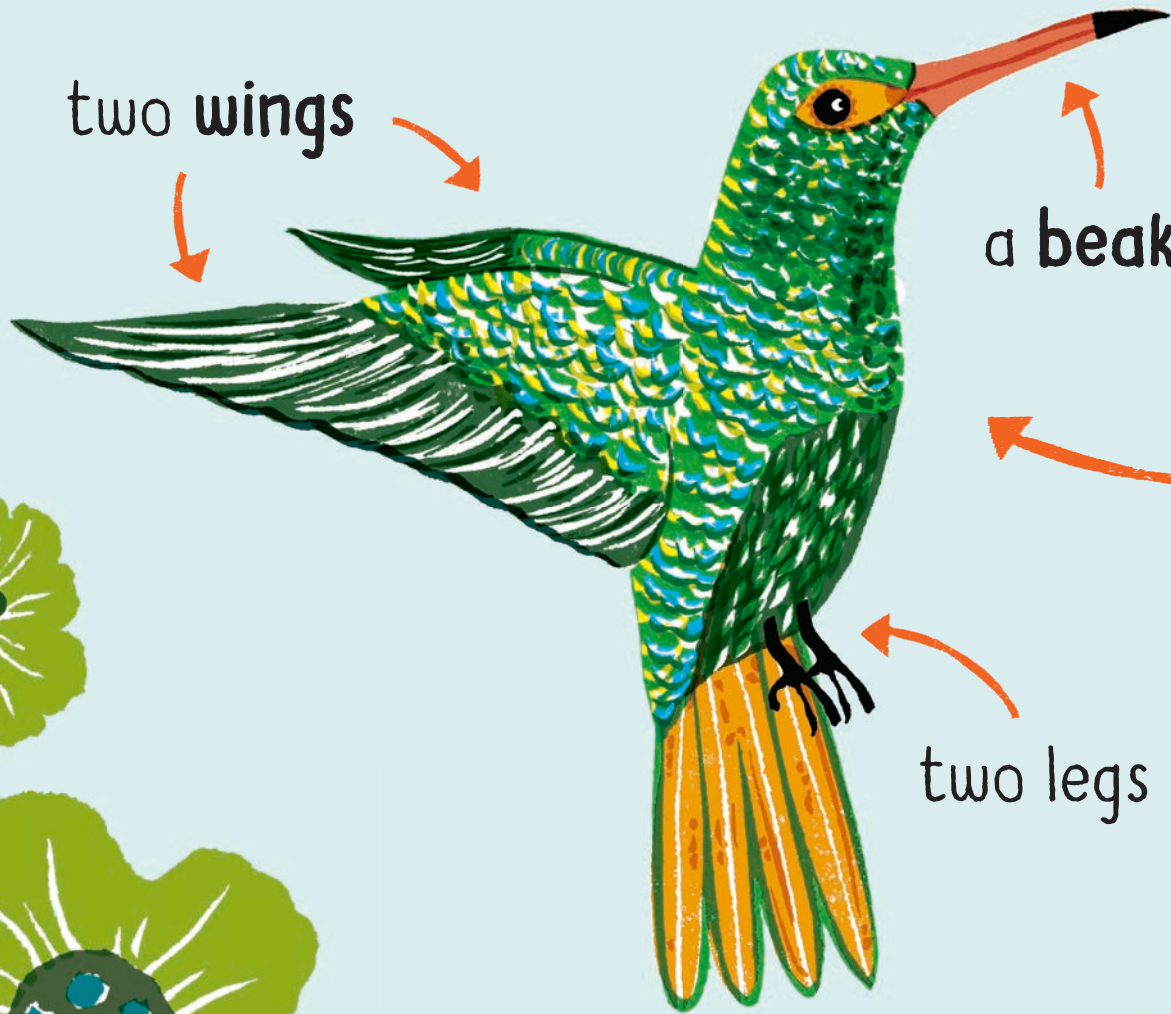
two wings

Baby birds, like this chick, hatch from **eggs** laid by their mother.



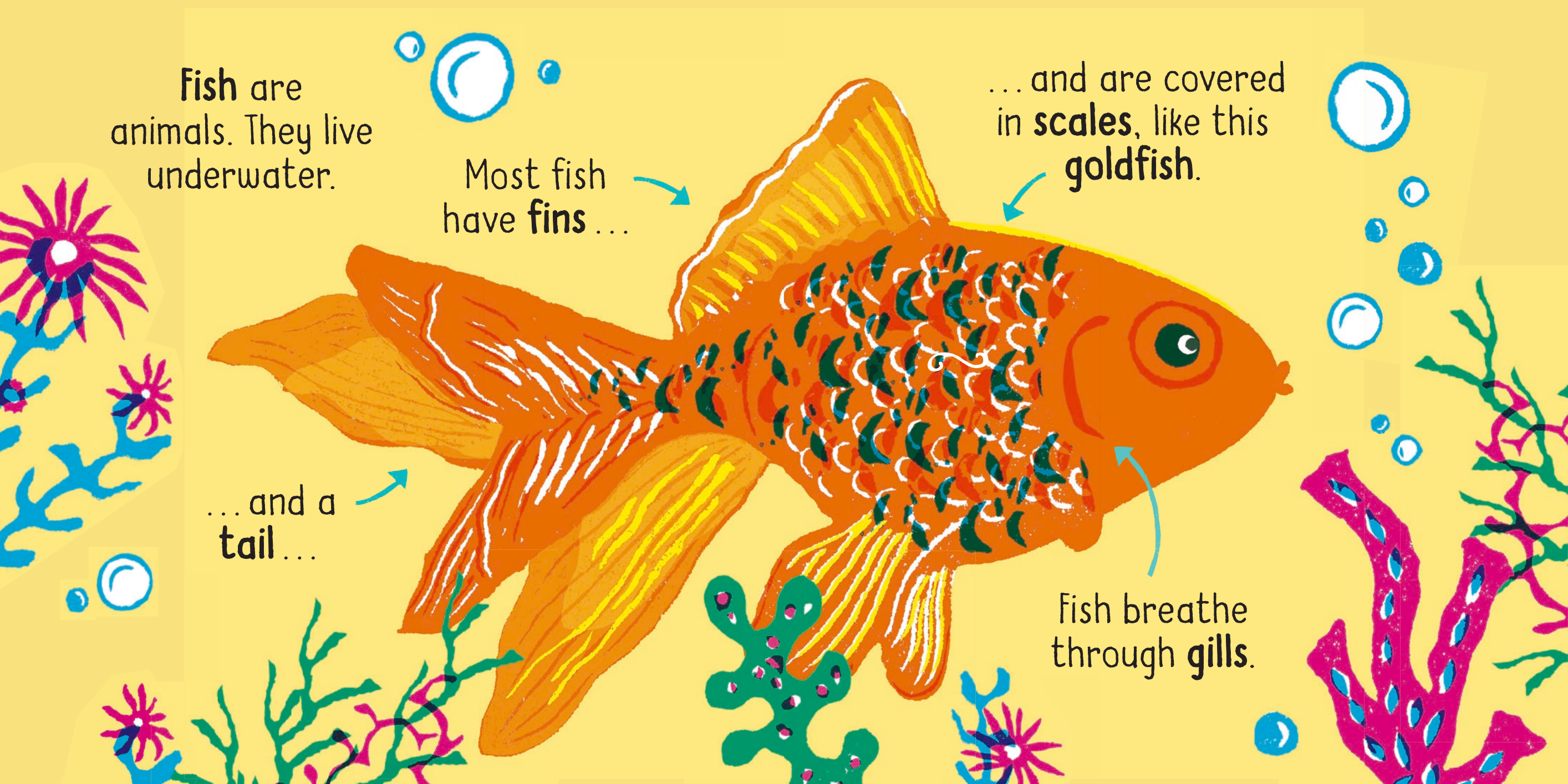
Fish are animals. They live underwater.
