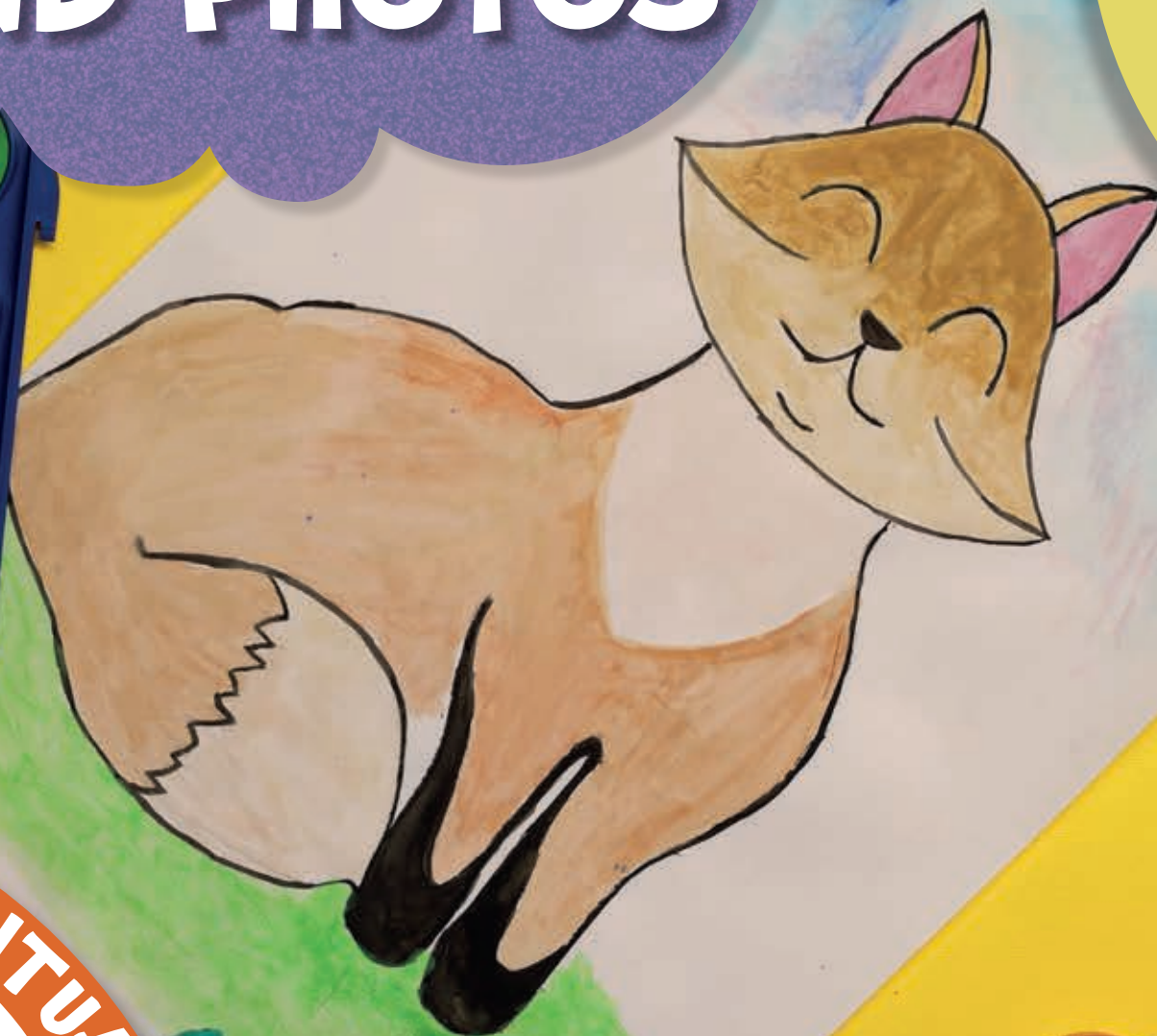

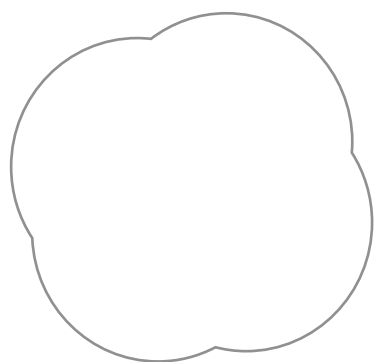

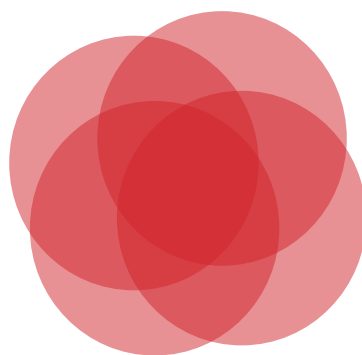
There are many colours.

Red, yellow and blue are primary colours.

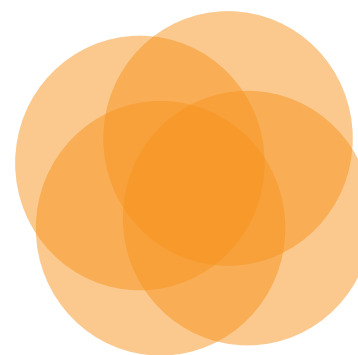
